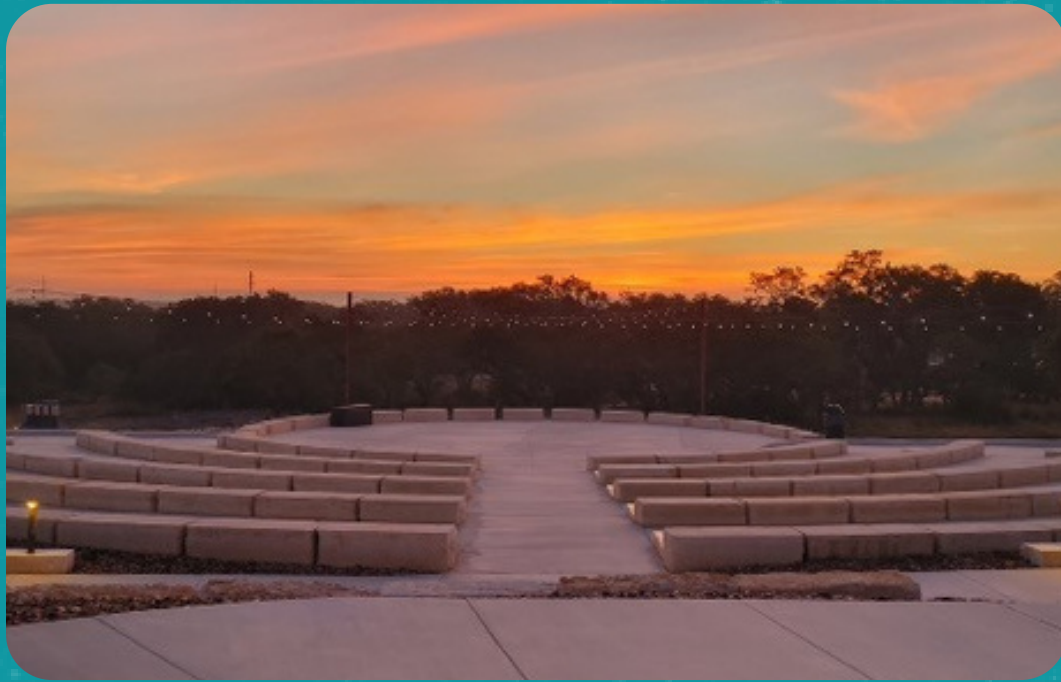

ABOUT MORGAN'S CAMP



Morgan's Camp is a state-of-the-art facility that will give us the opportunity to stretch our legs a bit, experience the joy created in spaces built to foster connections, and engage in a whole lot of fun together in amazing activity areas!

Morgan's Camp is a new, \$34 million campsite on 102 tree-studded acres of rolling hills in the heart of San Antonio, Texas. The site was built with community and connections in mind, creating beautiful areas that are a blank canvas ready to be adapted to meet the specific needs of Camp SAY's campers and programming. The mission and commitment of the staff of Morgan's Camp fit together beautifully with our Camp SAY Community Standards. Their model is built to support programs that create a space of belonging for underserved populations. Morgan's Camp has committed to being our host for as long as we want to be there.

The camp features Hartman Hall, a 30,000-square-foot facility, housing a dining hall. The state-of-the-art stage is perfect for presentations, performances, and entertainment. It offers a complete A/V system with a 34.5-foot diagonal projector screen and two 75-inch TV screens on each side of the stage for optimal viewing. There's also a large air conditioned arts and crafts center that includes a library and a digital photography studio.

From granite countertops to **temperature-controlled cabins**, each bunk has twin extra-large beds, storage cubbies, and microban flooring throughout the cabin, so it's easy to sanitize. Each cabin has a front porch prime for relaxing and taking in the night air.

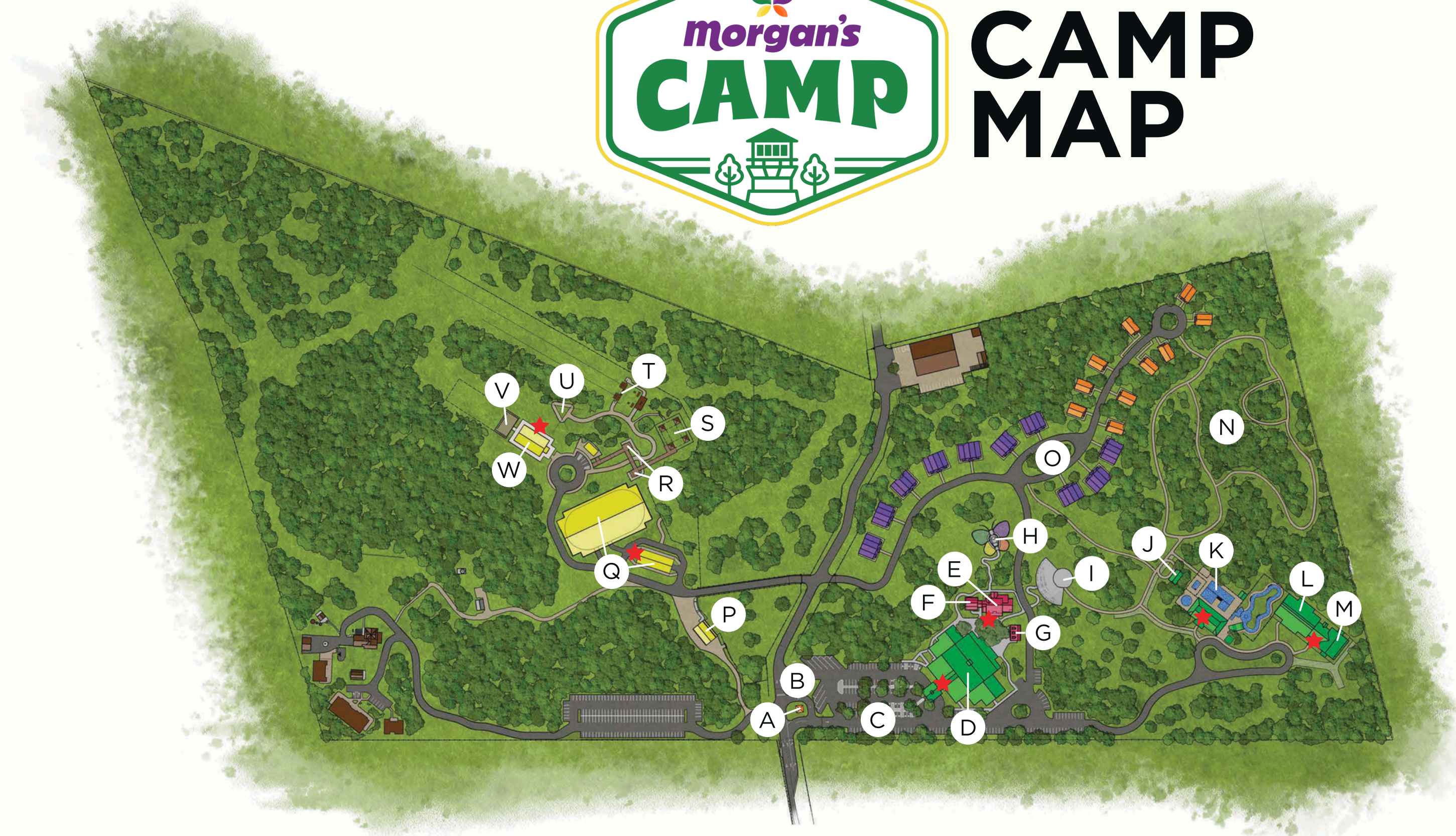
